Qualifications:

- 1. Must have a current and nursing license in the state of TN. (OB/GYN experience preferred).
- 2. Committed Christian who demonstrates a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and is accountable to a local Bible-believing church.
- 3. Agreement with Choices' Statement of Principle, Statement of Faith, Mission Statement, and policies of the organization, and is committed to the Ministry of Choices.
- 4. Strong commitment to the sanctity of human life and biblical sexual ethics and have a sincere desire to reach and help at-risk patients considering abortion.
- 5. Proven management skills including, problem-solving, clear communication, excellent administrative skills, the capacity for motivation and able to provide constructive feedback.
- 6. Effectively manage assigned projects, carry out responsibilities with minimal supervision and complete tasks as required.
- 7. Availability to work flexible hours including evenings and weekends as needed.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Responsible for opening/closing the lab as assigned (cleaning, stocking, opening/closing Pathgroup Connect, etc.).
- 2. Provide care to patients, by assessing patient needs and establishing a plan of care in accordance with established Choices' policies and procedures.
- 3. Inventory medical supplies and make requests for purchases as per Choices' policy.
- 4. Oversee patient follow-ups per patient care plan.
- 5. Follow up with patients regarding normal diagnosis of STI results.
- 6. Manage payments for prescriptions from partnering pharmacies.
- 7. Shared team duties; participate in the organization/tidiness and cleanliness of the reception, lobby, bathrooms, lab, volunteer room, etc.
- 8. Obtain CEU and CMEs as required to maintain current license.
- 9. Practice within the boundaries authorized by state licensing authorities.
- 10. Ensure accurate implementation of Nurse Practitioners' and Medical Director's orders.
- 11. Other duties as assigned.
