Choices aspires to be an organization that creates, promotes, and protects a culture of life. This commitment affirms our desire to be known more for what we are for than what we are against. This leads us to place greater emphasis on holistic care by broadening our services and partnerships touching the spiritual, emotional, and physical health of those we serve. This shapes our organization's design, enabling us to strategically execute our historic mission in a changing world.

Statement of Faith

1. We believe the Bible to be the only authoritative word of God; inspired, infallible and profitable for doctrine, reproof, correction, and instruction in righteousness.
2. We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, and His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His personal resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.
4. We believe that for the salvation of lost and sinful man, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential, and that this salvation is received by grace through faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and not as a result of good works.
5. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life and to perform good works.
6. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.
7. We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.

Operational Guidelines

1. Choices is an outreach ministry of Jesus Christ through members of His church. Choices is committed to presenting the gospel of our Lord in both word and deed to those in unplanned pregnancies. Therefore, Choices board members, employees, and volunteers are expected to know Christ as Savior and Lord.
2. Choices is committed to providing its clients with accurate and complete information about both prenatal development and abortion.
3. Choices is committed to assisting women to carry their unborn children to term by providing emotional support and practical assistance. Through the provision of God's people and the community at large, Choices will assist women and men to face the future with hope and plan constructively for themselves and their babies.
4. Choices does not discriminate in providing services because of the race, creed, color, natural origin, handicap, age, or marital status of its clients. Choices does not recommend, provide, or refer for abortion or abortifacients. Created in God's image, human life is worthy of protection from conception. Choices is morally opposed to abortion, as it is the killing of an innocent human being. Choices recognizes there may be rare occasions, when the mother's physical life is endangered and the life of the child cannot be preserved, where action may be taken to preserve the mother's life.
5. Choices offers its services free of charge at all times.

6. Choices is committed to creating awareness within the local community of the needs of pregnant women and of the fact that abortion only compounds human need rather than resolving it.
7. Choices does not recommend, provide, or refer single women for contraceptives.
8. Choices recognizes the validity of adoption as one alternative to abortion but is not biased toward adoption when compared to the other lifesaving alternatives. Choices is independent of any adoption agencies, relating to them in the same manner as to other helpful referral sources. Choices receives no payment of any kind from these agencies and does not enter into contractual relationships with them. Choices neither initiates nor facilitates independent adoptions, though it may refer clients for independent adoptions in states where this is legal.
